Minutes of Annual General Meeting

Minutes of Last Meeting:

The Minutes of the last meeting were agreed.

Finance Report:

There is a balance of £776.99. The accounts have not yet been signed off and are still with the Acting Treasurer.

The largest expenditure has been the two Wine and Wisdom nights which were both well attended.

The monthly Coffee Morning in St Stephens Church Hall generally breaks even and may even be starting to show a slight profit.

What has happened:

A meeting was held in June with Andy, Barrie and Bryony with Adam Paynter regarding traffic problems. Adam Paynter contacted Oliver who is Head of Highways at CORMAC, following which a meeting was then held with Oliver.

Ways of slowing traffic, continuation of 20mph at top of St Stephens Hill, bollards in Duke Street, island crossing and road markings were all discussed. The discussion stated that it was often easier to lump changes together as putting things through separately cost £2000 per time.

Some road markings have already been repainted with more to follow at a later date.

A road island opposite the church, or maybe raised paintwork, was also discussed.

The committee was told that the sum of £50,000 per year to run for 3 years had been provided by the Government to cover all 13 parishes as the Community Network Scheme to be used for various projects. A Council meeting was held on 20th September in the town hall to decide which projects would be covered by this funding but no decision has been received yet.

The Council had been asked to arrange for the leaves and vegetation to be cleared and cut back from St Stephens Hill and this has now been done.
