

## PROBLEM

Speed Camera on entering 30 mile limit from all directions also noise exhaust fitted to private cars  
St Stephens Hill Traffic  
Speed and noise of traffic - especially Heavy goods vehicles  
The speed bumps seem to speed up the cars as they come over to the side of the road - have nearly knocked over my son and elderly neighbours.  
They have had the adverse affect

Speed is my main concern - trying to cross to mail a letter is taking your life in your hands  
Too many lorries thundering down from yeolmbridge and into the village. They go so fast they have to cut to the middle of the road to get through  
The amount of very large heavy goods vehicles on the stretch of road passing our homes - The possibility of some form of crossing especially for the elderly or children in our area  
The amount of traffic, especially the large number of big heavy lorries moving through newport and St Stephens to Werrington  
St Stephens Hill Traffic - install effecting traffic calming STOP sign at top of hill giving priority to Royden Road  
Traffic Speed  
St Stephens road should be one way - UP  
Using Underhayes lane as a rat run and turning from Egloskerry the wrong way on a dangerous corner  
crossing of road at the junction of roydon road and st stephens hill  
Vehicles ignoring No Entry sign on St Stephens Hill  
Speed a huge problem and no safe crossing places throughout the area  
Siting of bollard in St Stephens Hill too close to corner as cant see up coming traffic until you are in the middle of the road. Dangerous - accident waiting to happen due to speed of traffic  
Junction from underhayes lane with St Stephens hill visibility bad due to BT boxes obscuring view  
Congestion of moving and parked traffic on St Stephens Hill  
Traffic parked outside schools particularly St Stephens longer than necessary  
Parking or over parking in Duke Street  
Only need 1 parking space each in Duke Street  
Parking imeding passage Duke Street  
Parking on pavements on Duke Street and Obstructive parking  
Parking on North and Duke Street causing issues with traffic passing through both streets  
Parking on lower part of st stephens hill - suggest residents parking only giving residents a ticket  
Parking on pavements and at road junctions  
Parking their cars opposite my entrance - I cannot get my car out of my drive.  
Parking on pavements - driving too fast through the village  
Neighbourhood Watch  
Keen to promote social events and charity events  
Bad exit onto St Stephens Hill - Speed bumps don't work - trees overhanging number 7 Hollies Road  
the speed of the traffic through the whole of St Stephens  
Car parking at St Josephs - Parking of school staff vehicles on the hill causes very serious problems for the two way movement from St Cuthberts to Newport. The fact that during school holidays the hill is decidedly less congested proves where the problem lies. Subsequently when functions are being held at the school St Cuthbert close becomes their car park with vehicles parking on boh sides of the road. On occasions in the past it would have been impossible for a fire engine to enter the estate.  
Who has the right of way when walking in front of St Josephs entrance? Why do the parents want to run over people as they cross the entrance?  
There is no safe place for children to play away from busy roads in St Stephens. Also no social outlet for teenagers (Would a young peoples voice be a good thing for our residents association?)
